Commitment

Cast members are expected to attend all scheduled rehearsals, if you MUST miss a rehearsal please contact the director/producer asap to give us a better chance of rearranging scenes. Technical and dress rehearsals and of course performances are mandatory!

Punctuality

Call times for rehearsals and performances are for everyone's benefit, please be punctual. If you have a legitimate reason you are going to be late please contact a team member as soon as possible.

Phones can be a pain to others

Mobile phones should ideally be turned off during rehearsals and performances, if this isn't possible please be considerate but under no circumstances should they be taken on stage.

Drama on the stage please

Just because we play dramatic parts on stage does NOT mean we want drama off stage. When we are putting on a show the hall becomes a tiny universe, lets keep it a happy, fun place to be. If you have any issues, worries, grievances, please find a member of the committee or team leader that you can talk to. Positive attitudes lead to positive results. Disruptive behaviour will not be tolerated.

Respect

This goes not only for your fellow Players, but also for props, costumes, assets of the Neuadd Dyfi Hall and of the decisions made by the committee and production team.

Be Prepared

Always bring your script and a pencil to rehearsals, keep notes of your blocking etc. Learn your lines promptly and please study and practice outside of rehearsals. The sooner you know your part the sooner you can perfect it.

Help Out

The show is not just about you and your performance a lot more happens behind the scenes. Making tea washing cups set building, lighting, sound, costumes etc. Help always needed setting up the hall and most importantly clearing up the days after the last performance. It needs to be a full team effort.

Communicate

Lets talk! If you have an idea, if you have a problem, if you need something, lets talk about it.

Give Of Your Best Always give your best performance, whether that's at rehearsal, on opening night or for the last show. Please remember the people who buy tickets for the first show pay just as much as those who buy tickets for our final performance. Lets aim to make the first, last and all those in between the best performances we are all capable of.
